Why Is Humility Important?

Colossians 3:12 ¹² Therefore, as God's chosen people, holy and dearly loved, clothe yourselves with compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience.

Matthew 23:12 ¹² For those who exalt themselves will be humbled, and those who humble themselves will be exalted.

Proverbs 16:5 The LORD detests all the proud of heart.

Be sure of this: They will not go unpunished.

Matthew 5:3 *Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.

Proverbs 13:10 ¹⁰ Where there is strife, there is pride, but wisdom is found in those who take advice.

Proverbs 26:12 ¹² Do you see a person wise in their own eyes? There is more hope for a fool than for them.

⁶ Humble yourselves, therefore, under God's mighty hand, that he may lift you up in due time.
