## Acts 16: 37-39

<sup>37</sup> But Paul said to the officers: “They beat us publicly without a trial, even though we are Roman citizens, and threw us into prison. And now do they want to get rid of us quietly? No! Let them come themselves and escort us out.”

<sup>38</sup> The officers reported this to the magistrates, and when they heard that Paul and Silas were Roman citizens, they were alarmed. <sup>39</sup> They came to appease them and escorted them from the prison, requesting them to leave the city.

## 2 Samuel 16:6-11

<sup>6</sup> He pelted David and all the king's officials with stones, though all the troops and the special guard were on David's right and left. <sup>7</sup> As he cursed, Shimei said, "Get out, get out, you murderer, you scoundrel! <sup>8</sup> The LORD has repaid you for all the blood you shed in the household of Saul, in whose place you have reigned. The LORD has given the kingdom into the hands of your son Absalom. You have come to ruin because you are a murderer!"

## 2 Samuel 16:6-11

<sup>9</sup> Then Abishai son of Zeruiah said to the king, “Why should this dead dog curse my lord the king? Let me go over and cut off his head.”

<sup>10</sup> But the king said, “What does this have to do with you, you sons of Zeruiah? If he is cursing because the LORD said to him, ‘Curse David,’ who can ask, ‘Why do you do this?’”

## 2 Samuel 16:6-11

<sup>11</sup> David then said to Abishai and all his officials,  
“My son, my own flesh and blood, is trying to kill  
me. How much more, then, this Benjamite! Leave  
him alone; let him curse, for the LORD has told him  
to.

# 1 Peter 2:23

<sup>23</sup> When they hurled their insults at him, he did not retaliate; when he suffered, he made no threats. Instead, he entrusted himself to him who judges justly.
