²² Moreover, the Father judges no one, but has entrusted all judgment to the Son,

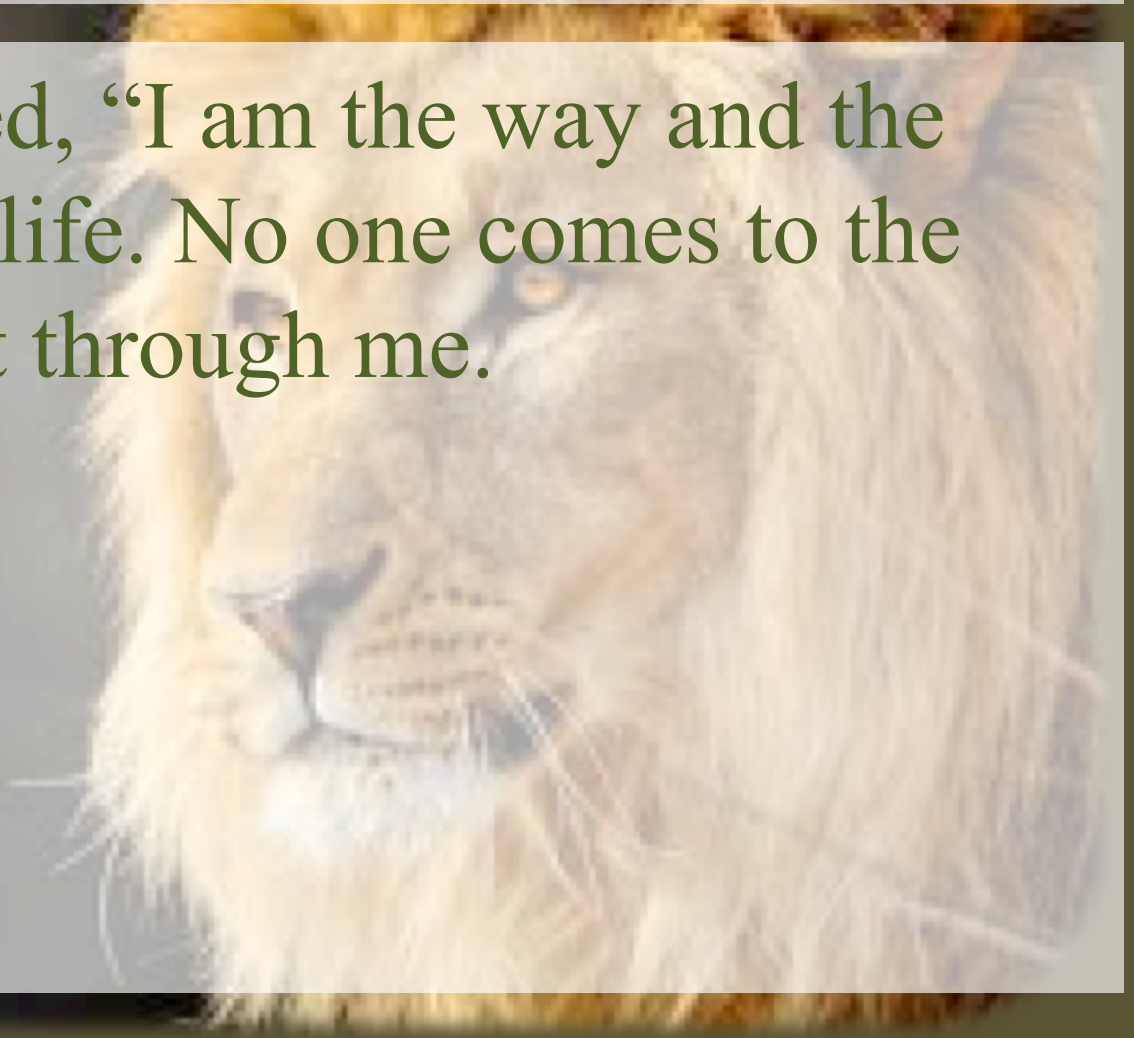


1 John 5:11-12 (niv)

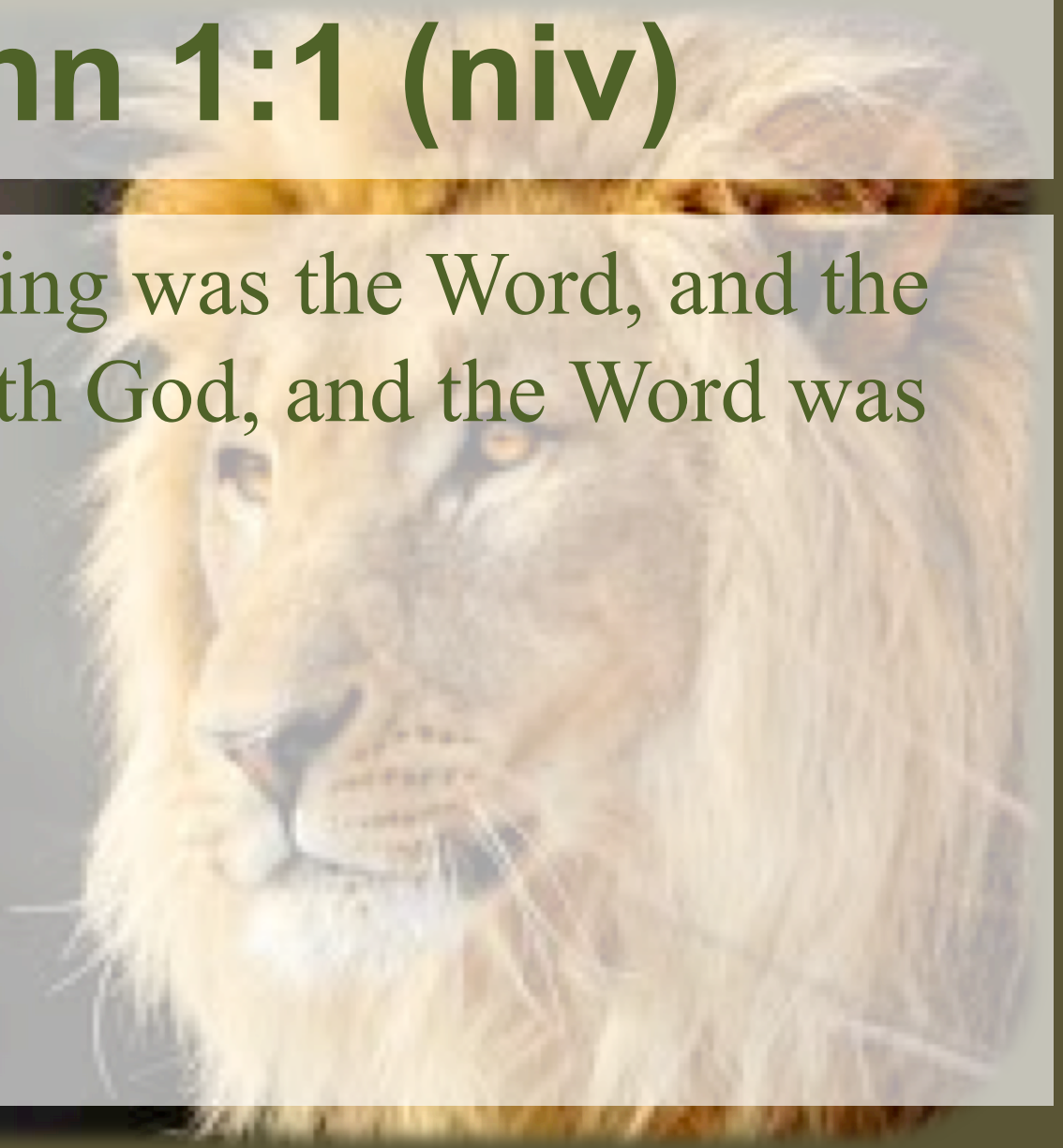

1 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.

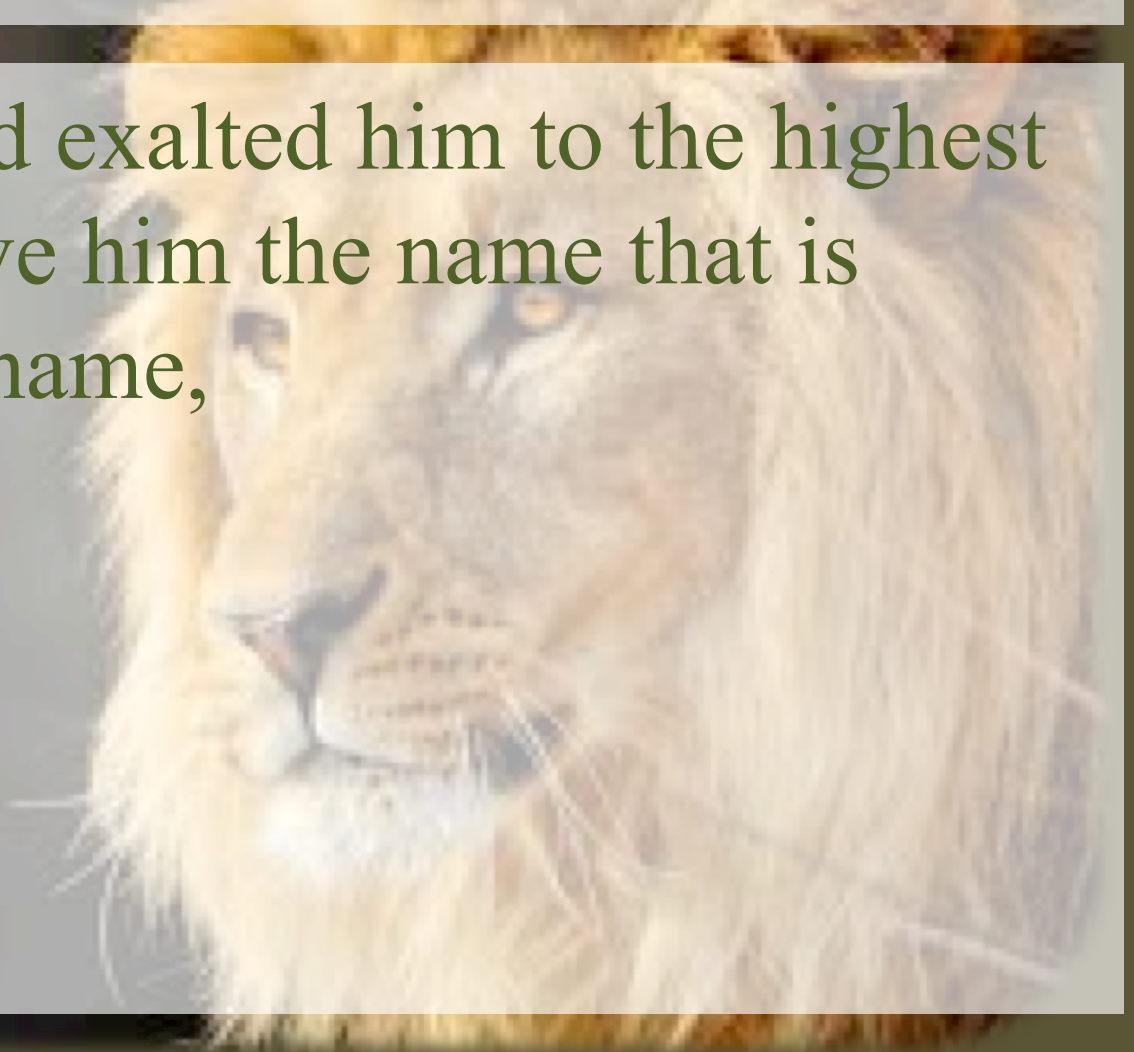


John 1:14 (niv)
