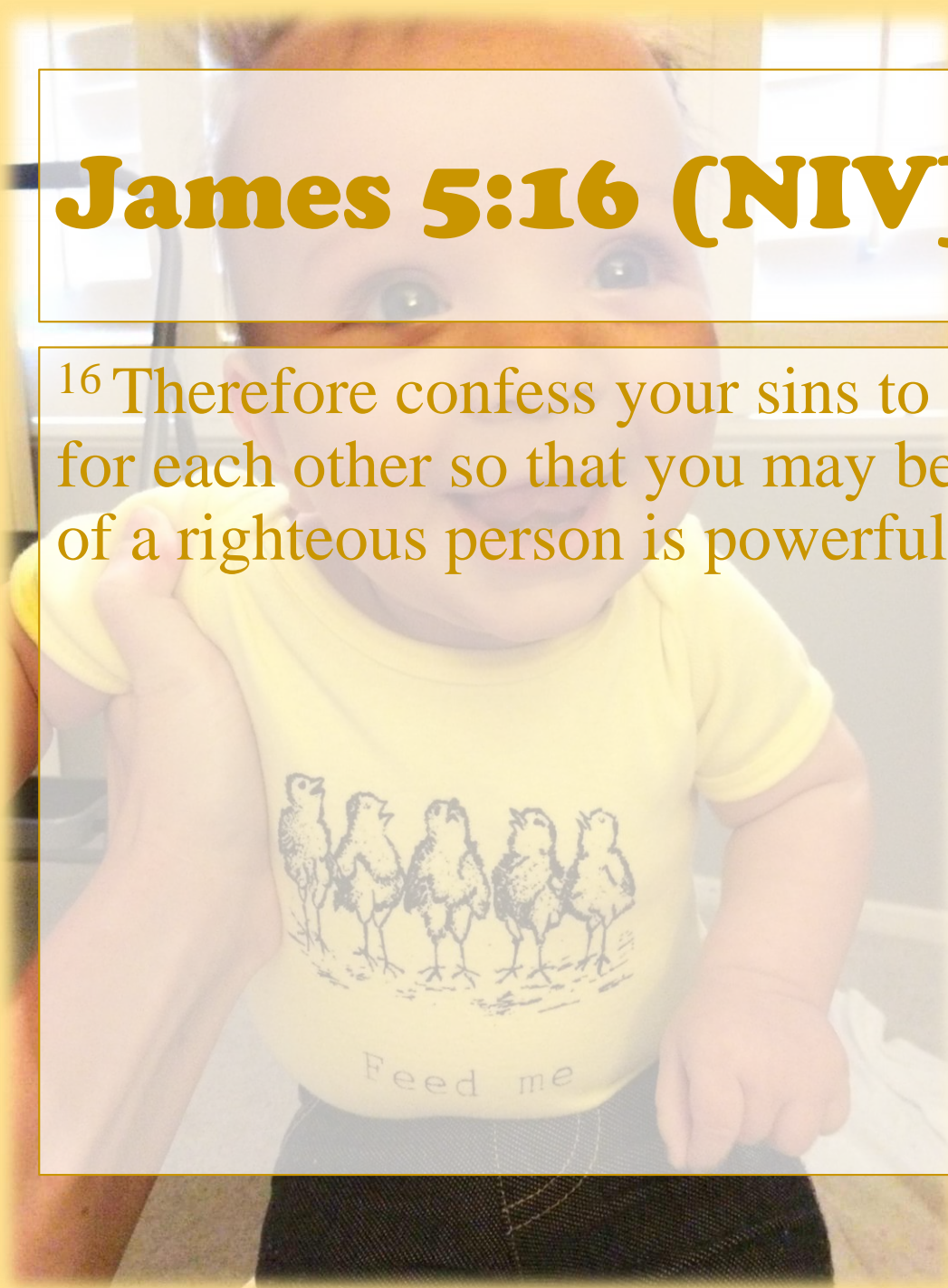

but victory rests with the LORD.



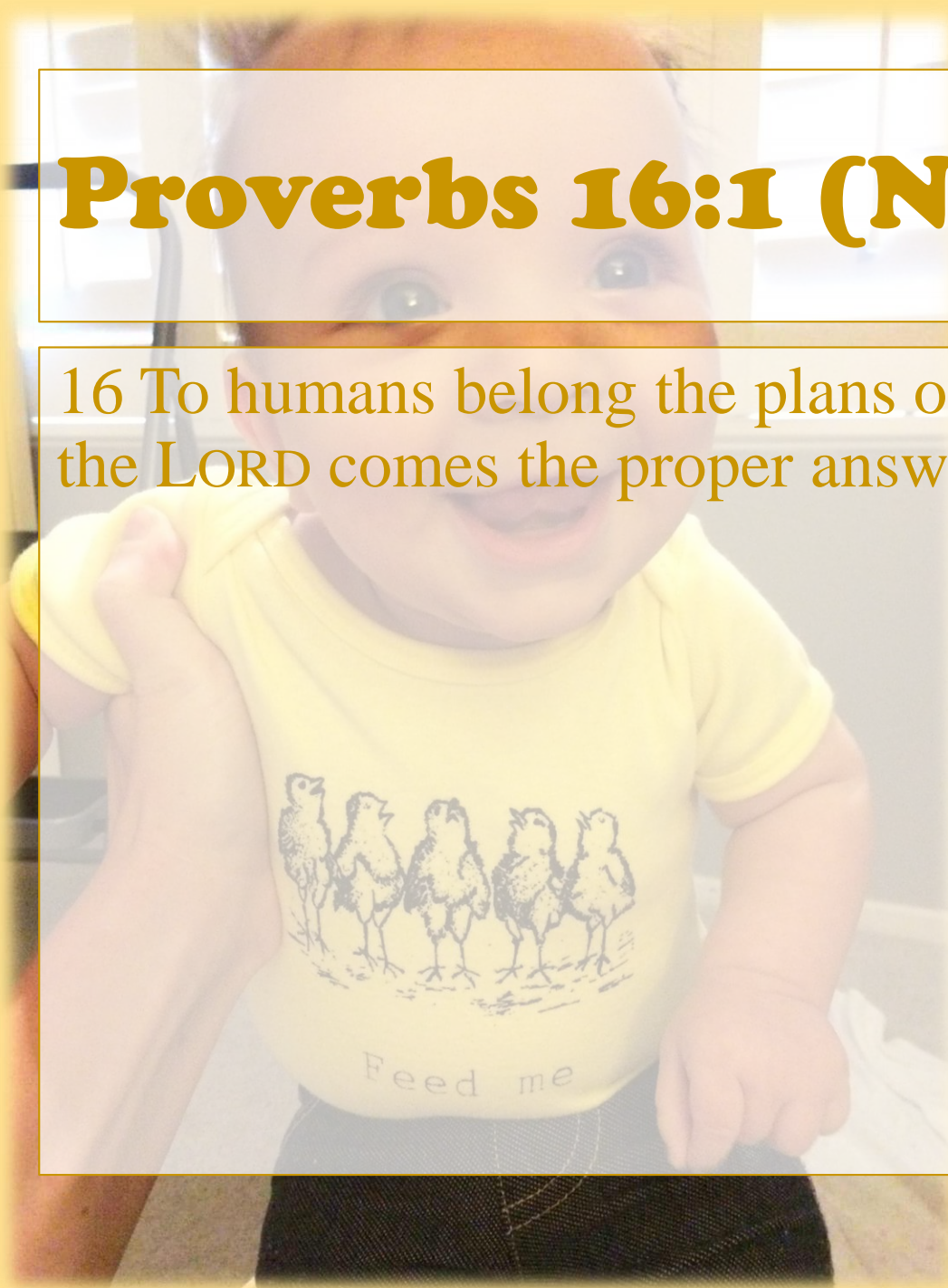
Proverbs 16:9 (NIV)

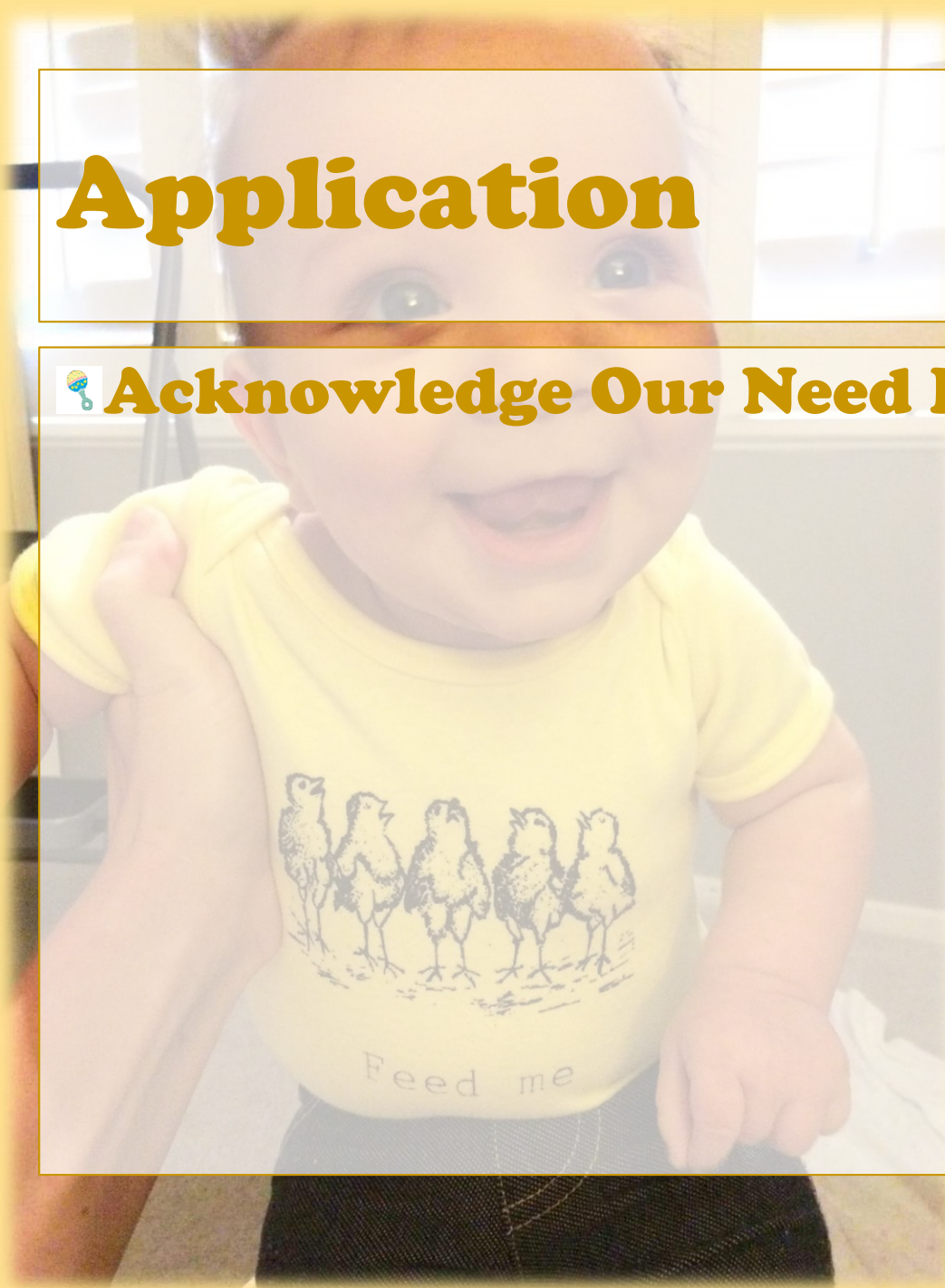
