# *1 Thessalonians 1:9-10 (NIV)*



## *Colossians 3:5 (NIV)*



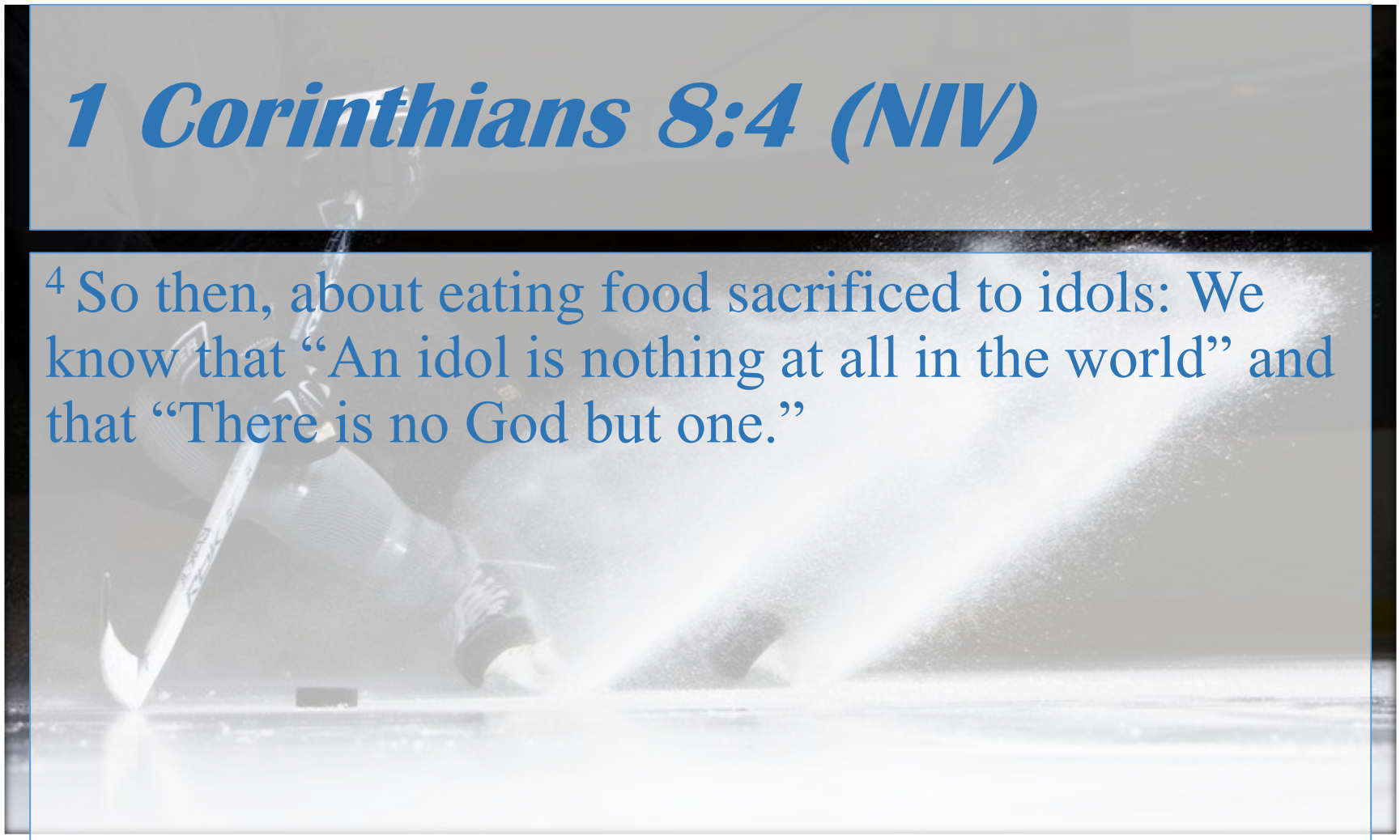
## *Ephesians 5:5 (NIV)*

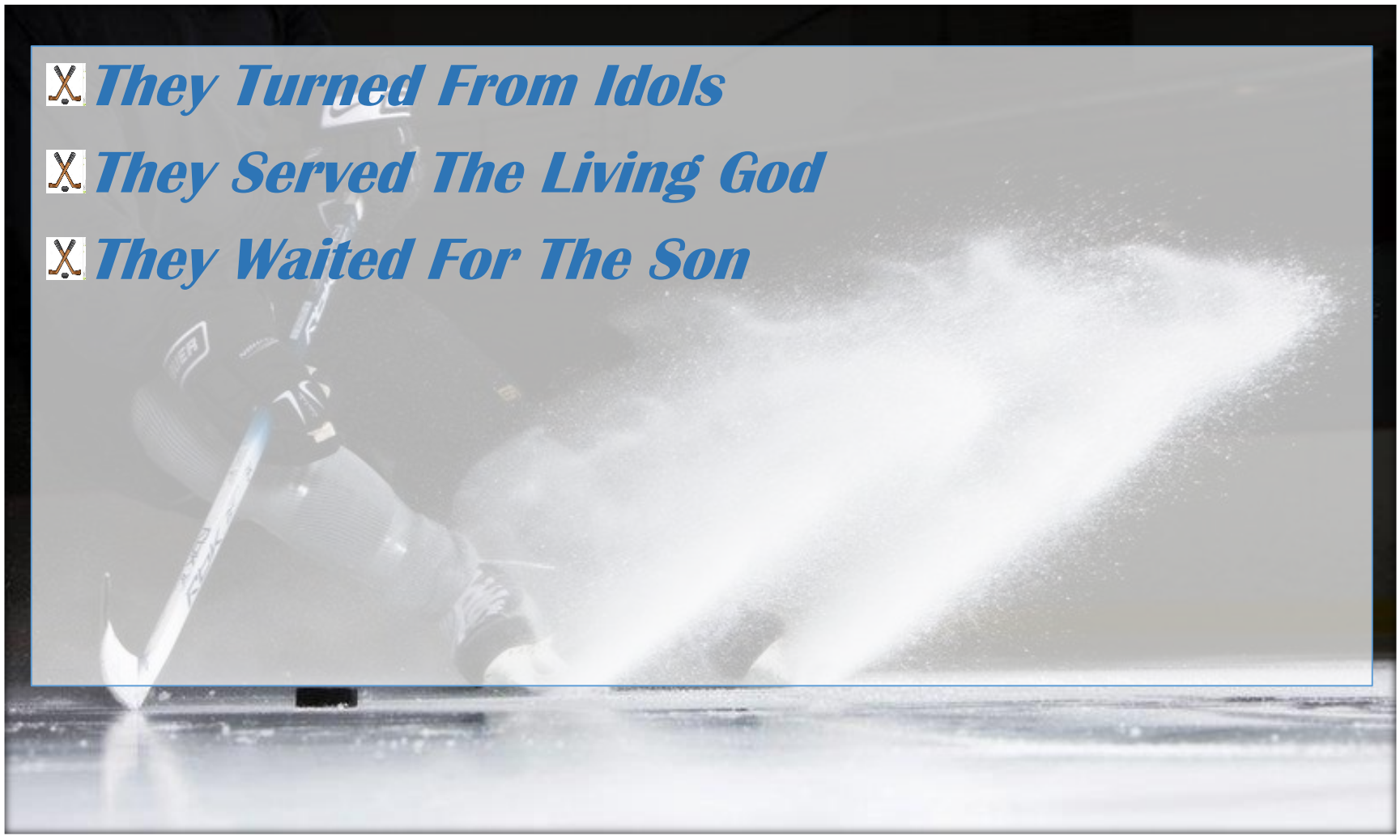

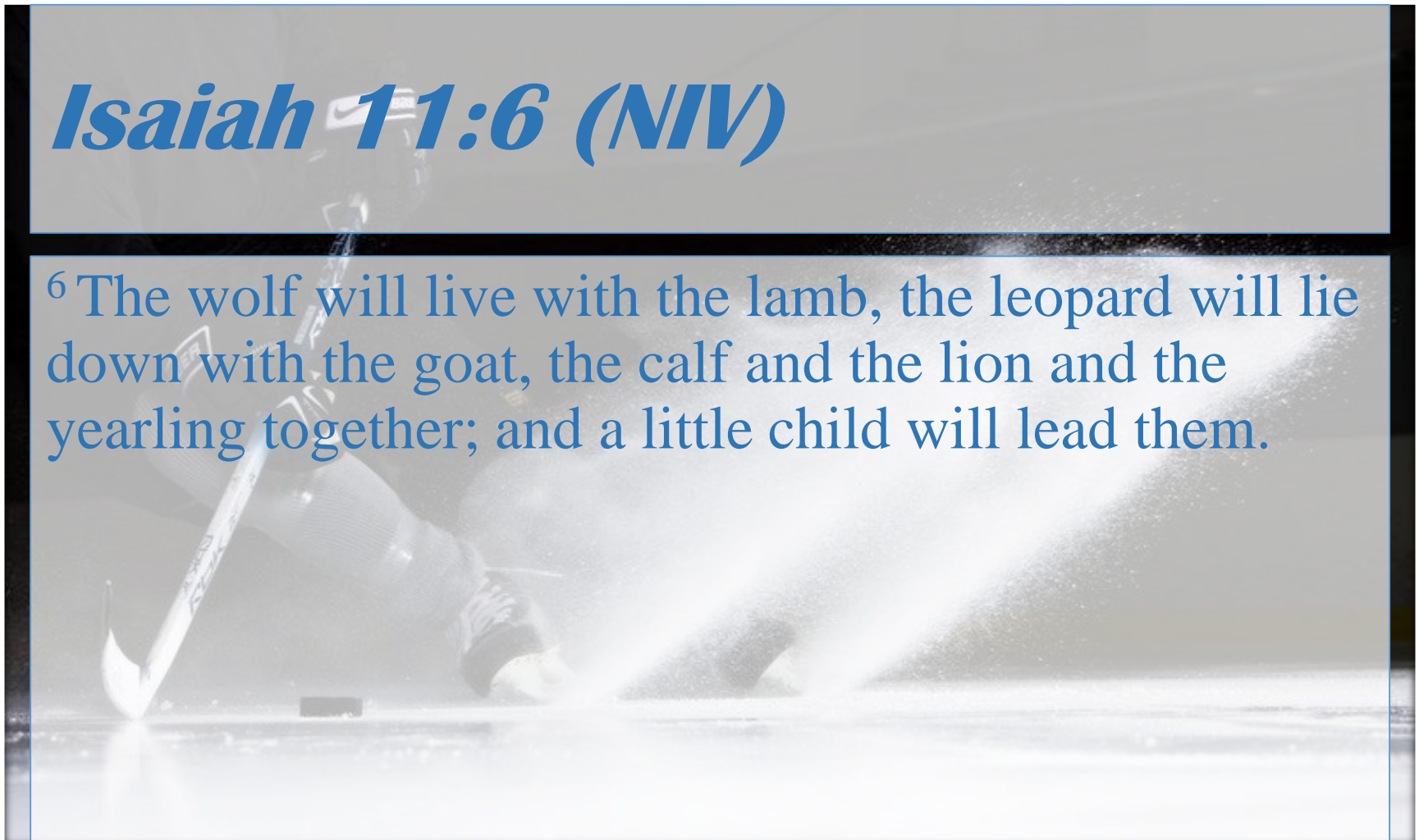

## *Isaiah 11:6 (NIV)*


<sup>6</sup>The wolf will live with the lamb, the leopard will lie down with the goat, the calf and the lion and the yearling together; and a little child will lead them.





## *Revelation 21:4 (NIV)*

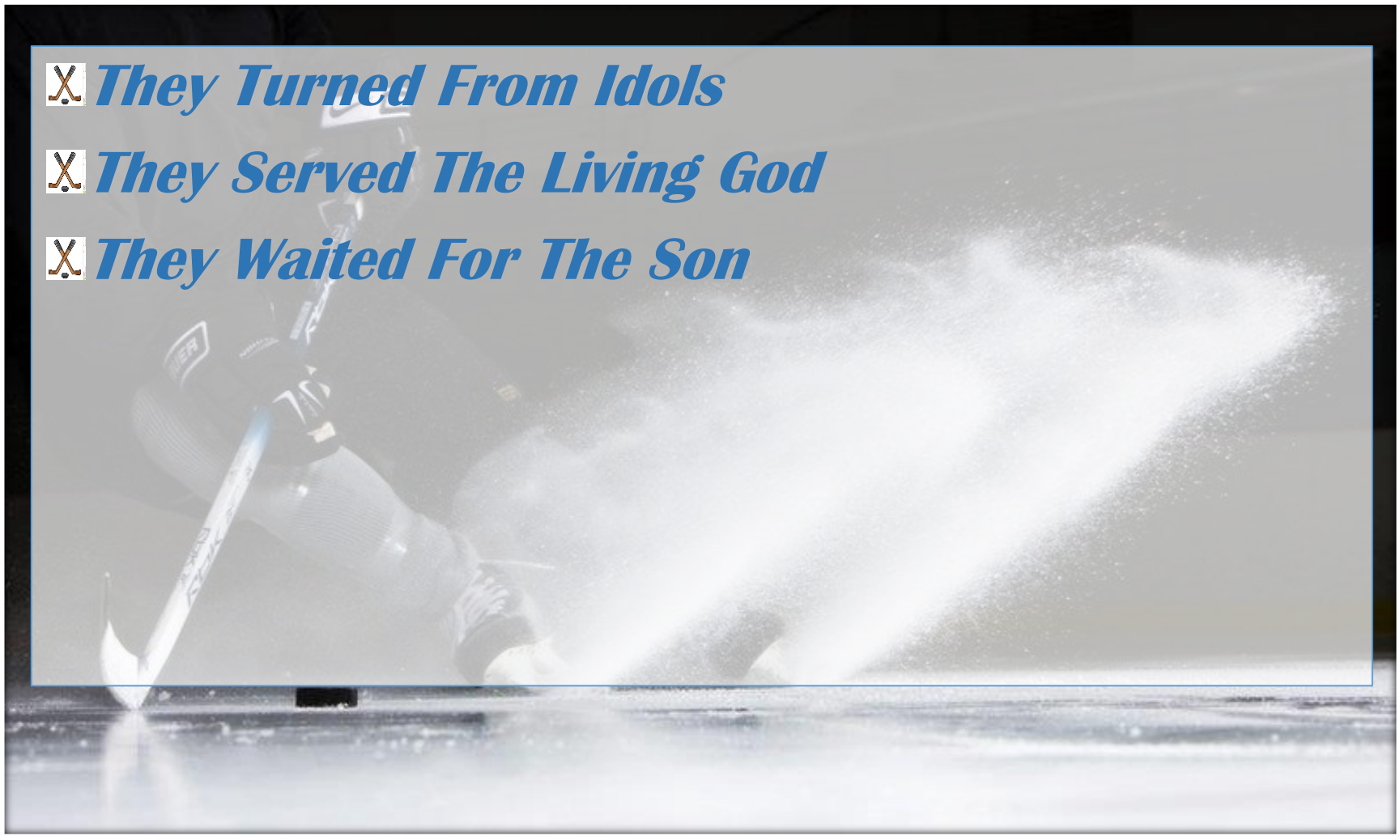
<sup>4</sup> ‘He will wipe every tear from their eyes. There will be no more death’ or mourning or crying or pain, for the old order of things has passed away.’”
