Lamentations 1:16 (NJV)

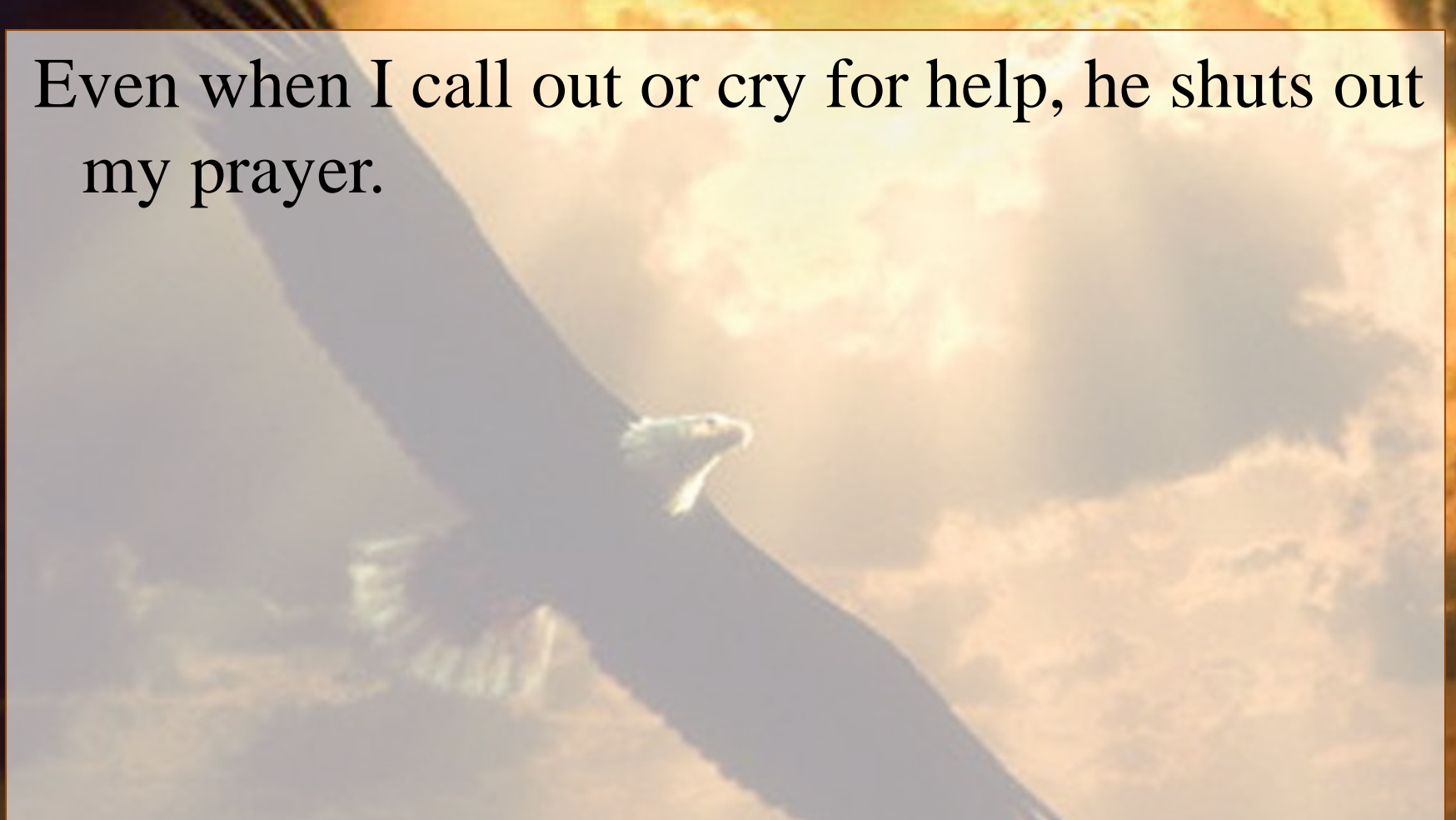

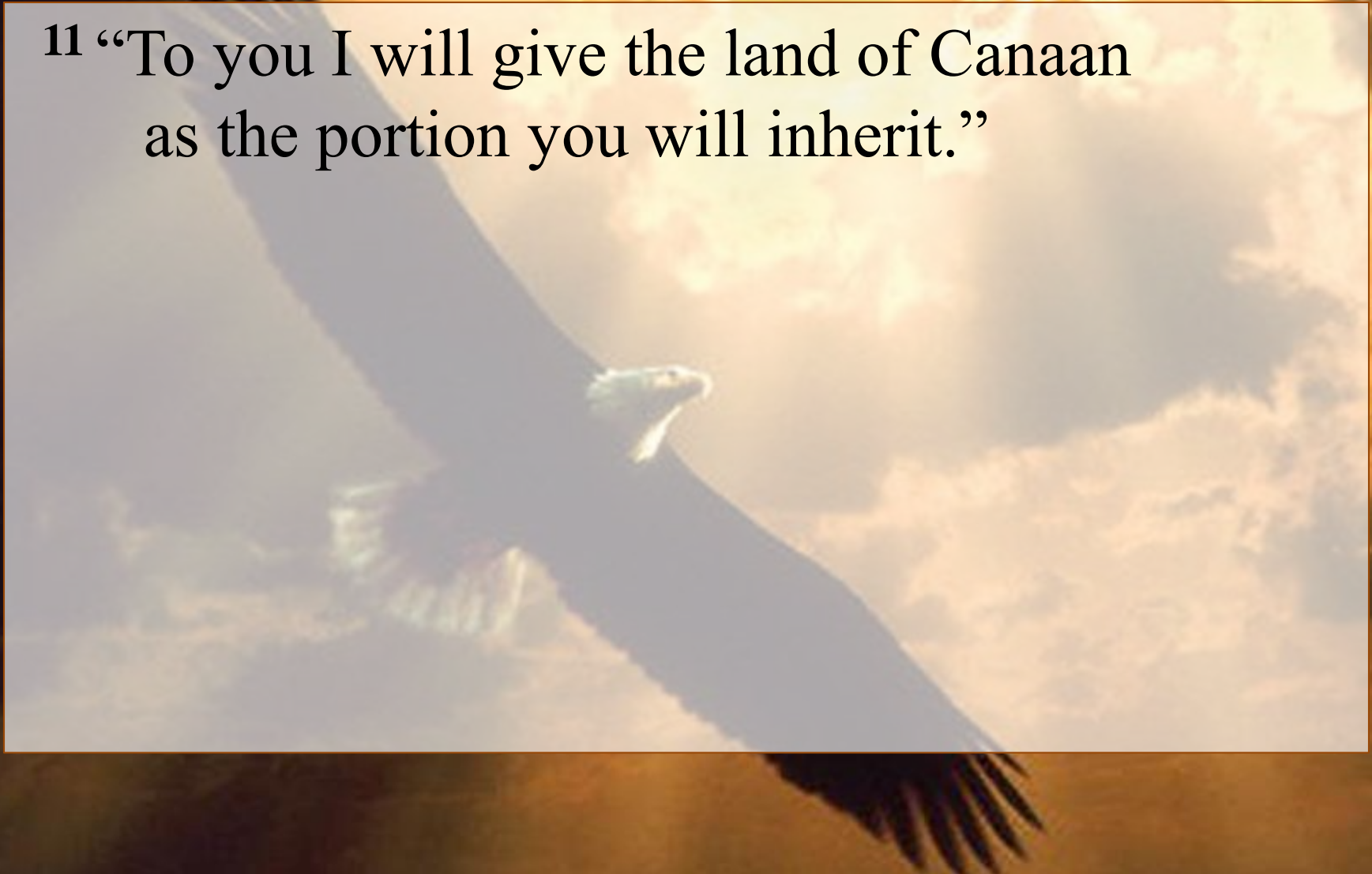


