



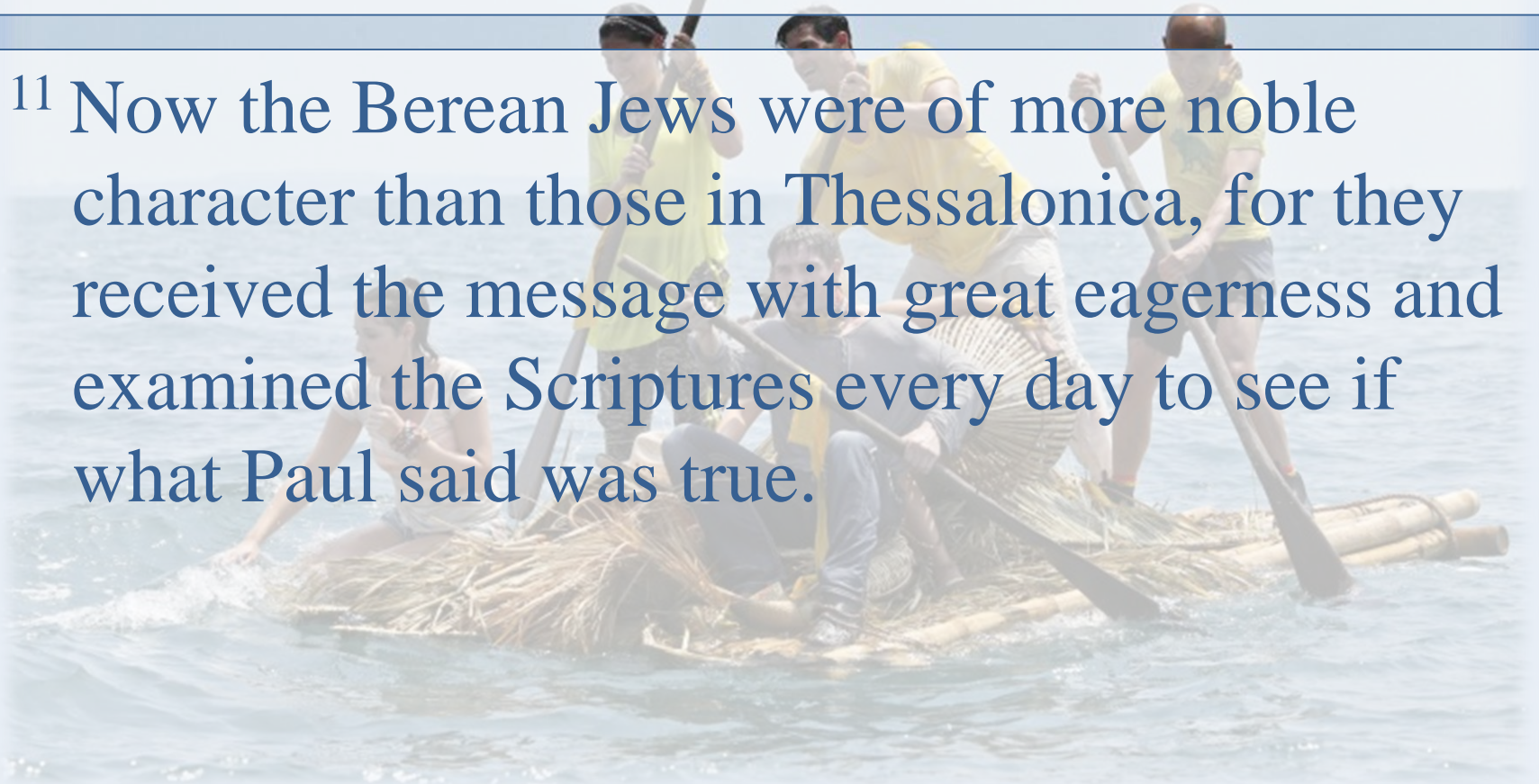
Acts 2:1-3 (NIV)

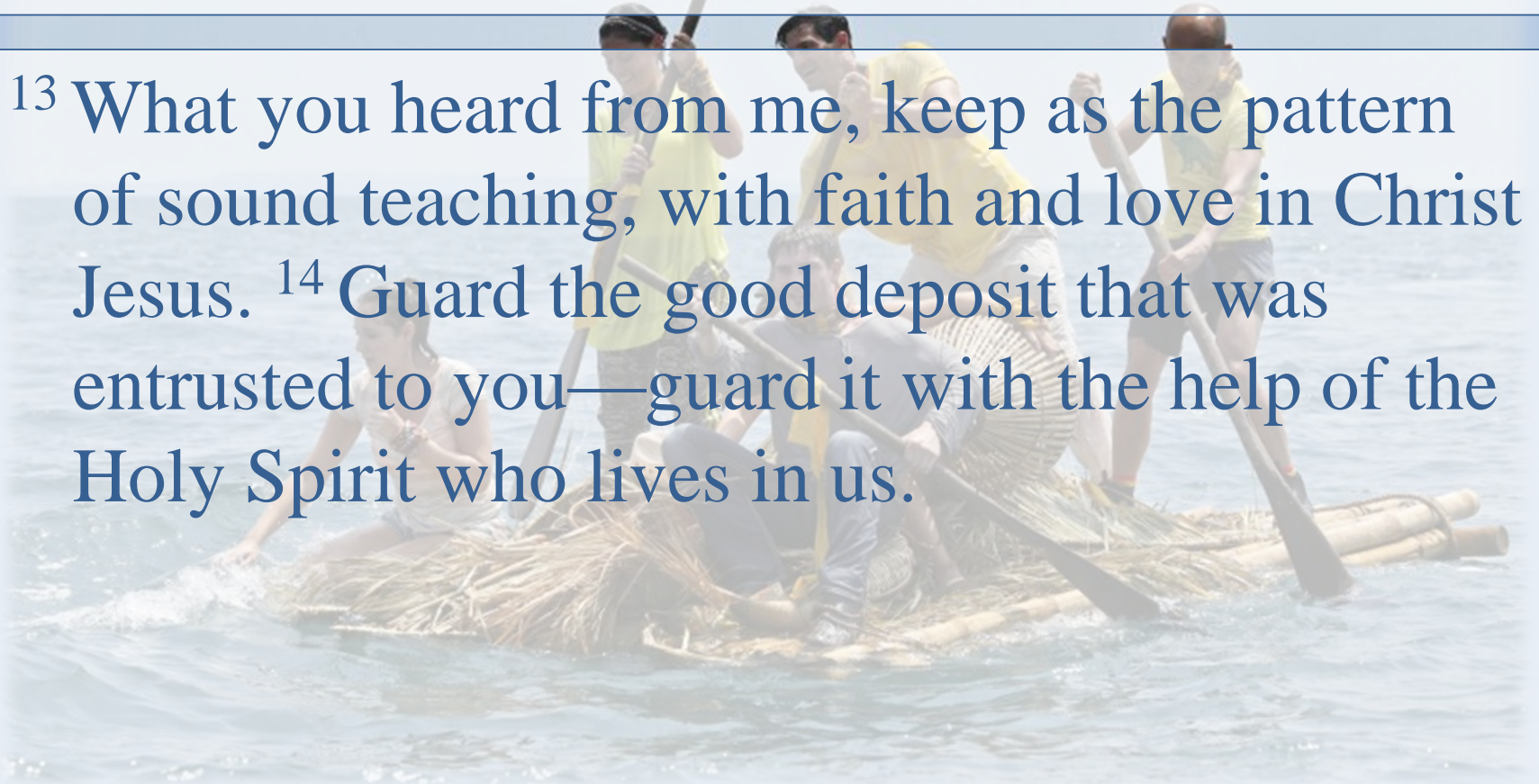
ACTS 17:11 (NIV)

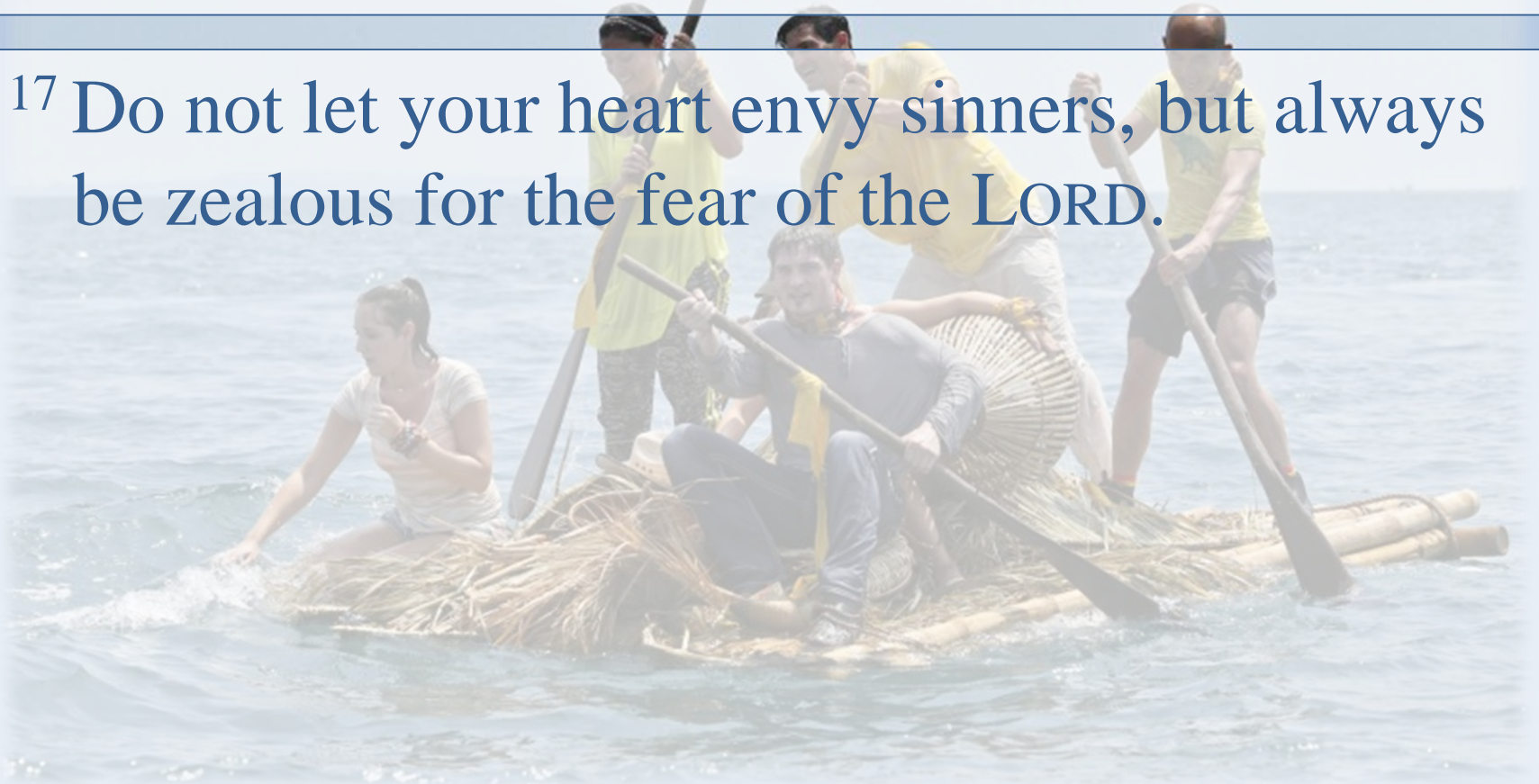
DEUTERONOMY 6:5 (NIV)

strength.



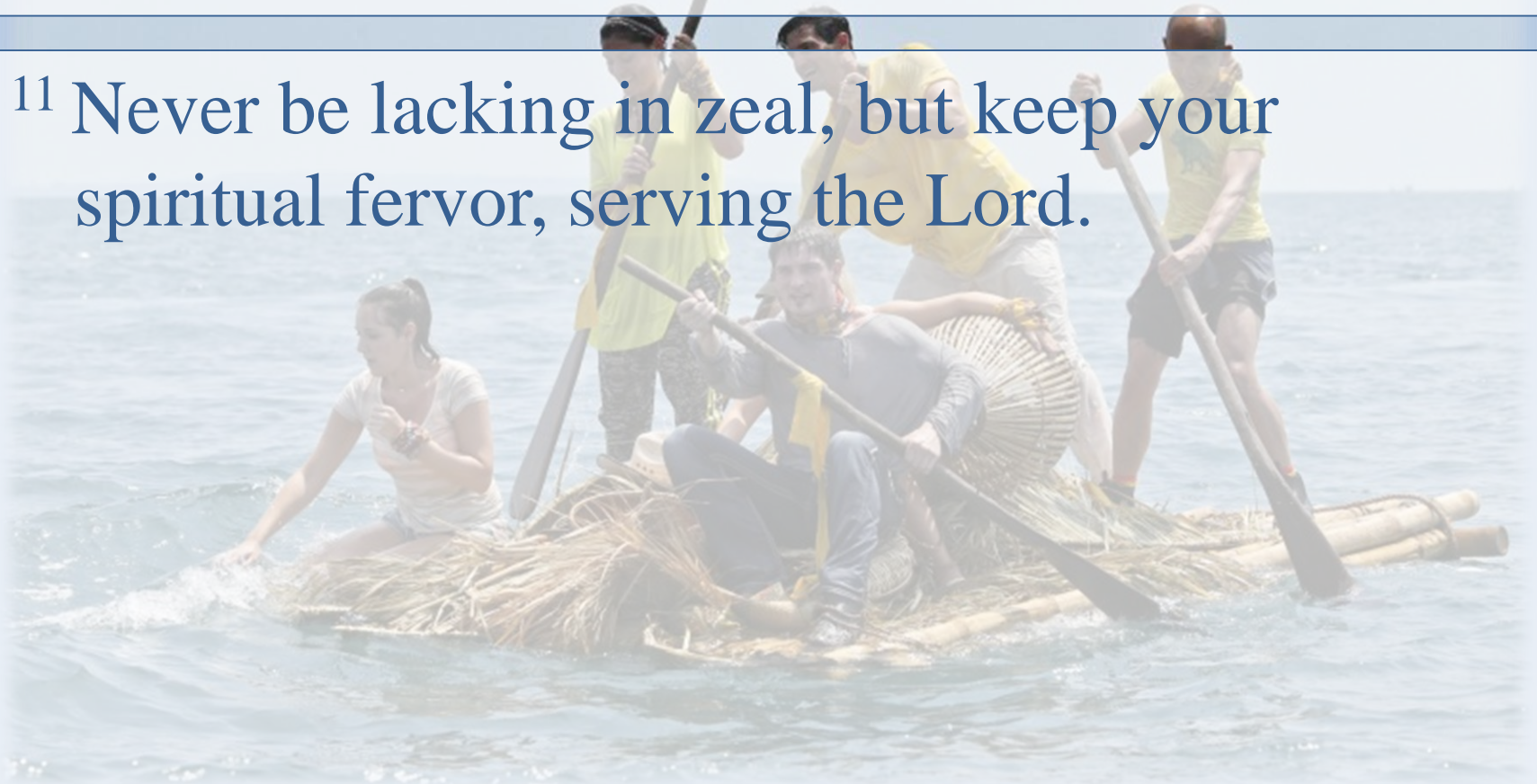
PROVERBS 23:17 (NIV)

¹⁷ Do not let your heart envy sinners, but always be zealous for the fear of the LORD.



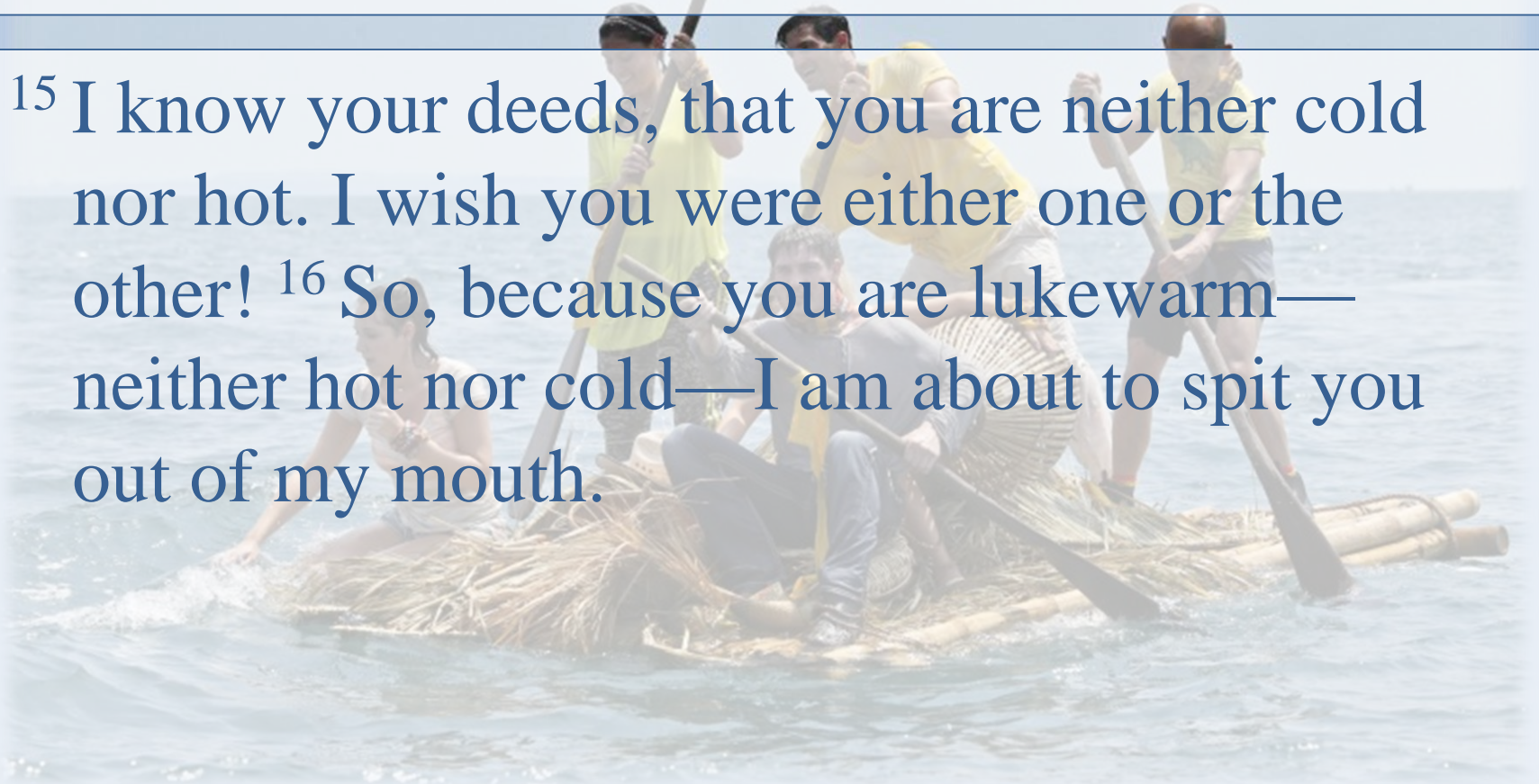
ROMANS 12:11 (NIV)

¹¹ Never be lacking in zeal, but keep your spiritual fervor, serving the Lord.



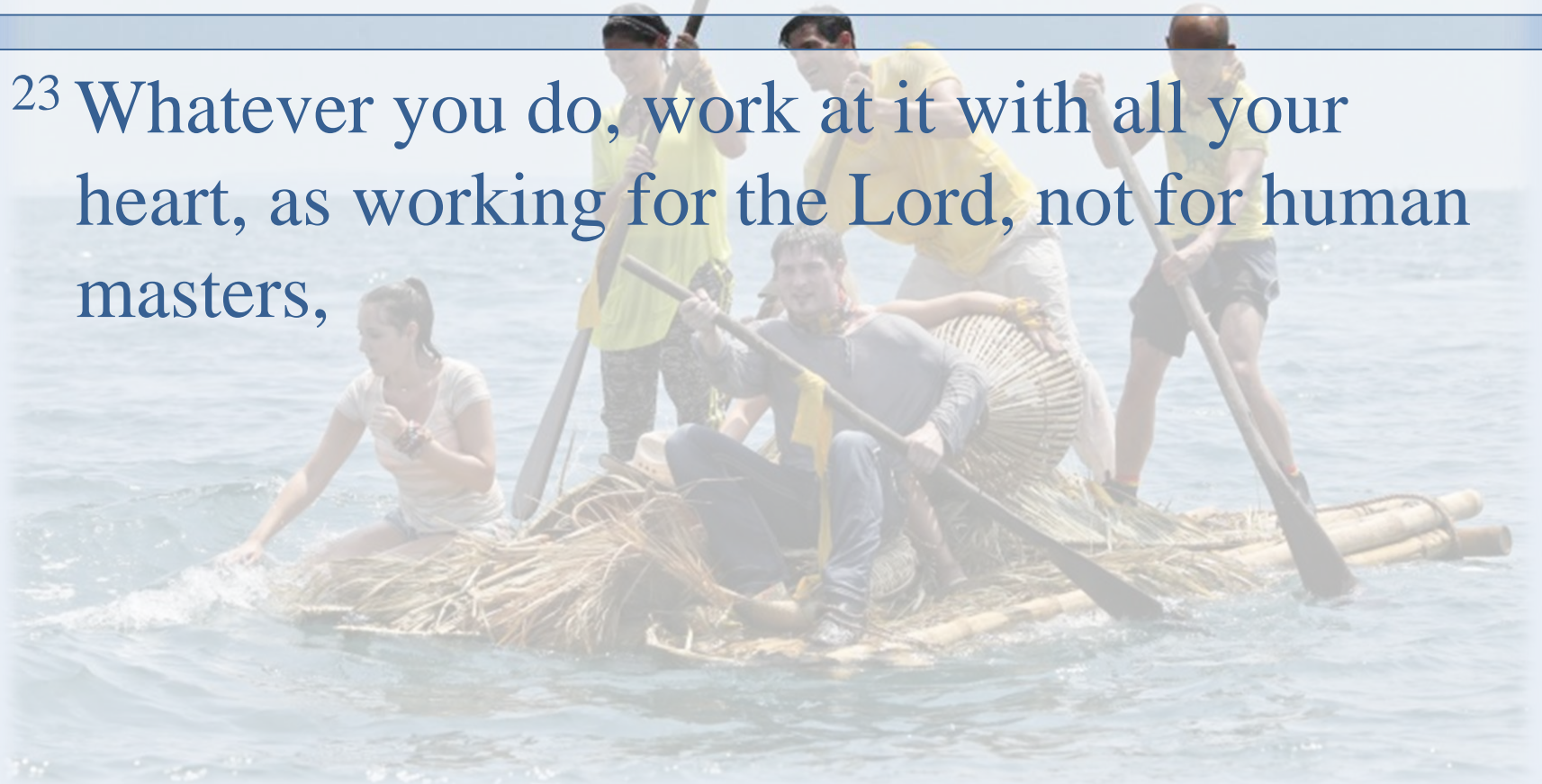
REVELATION 3:15-16 (NIV)

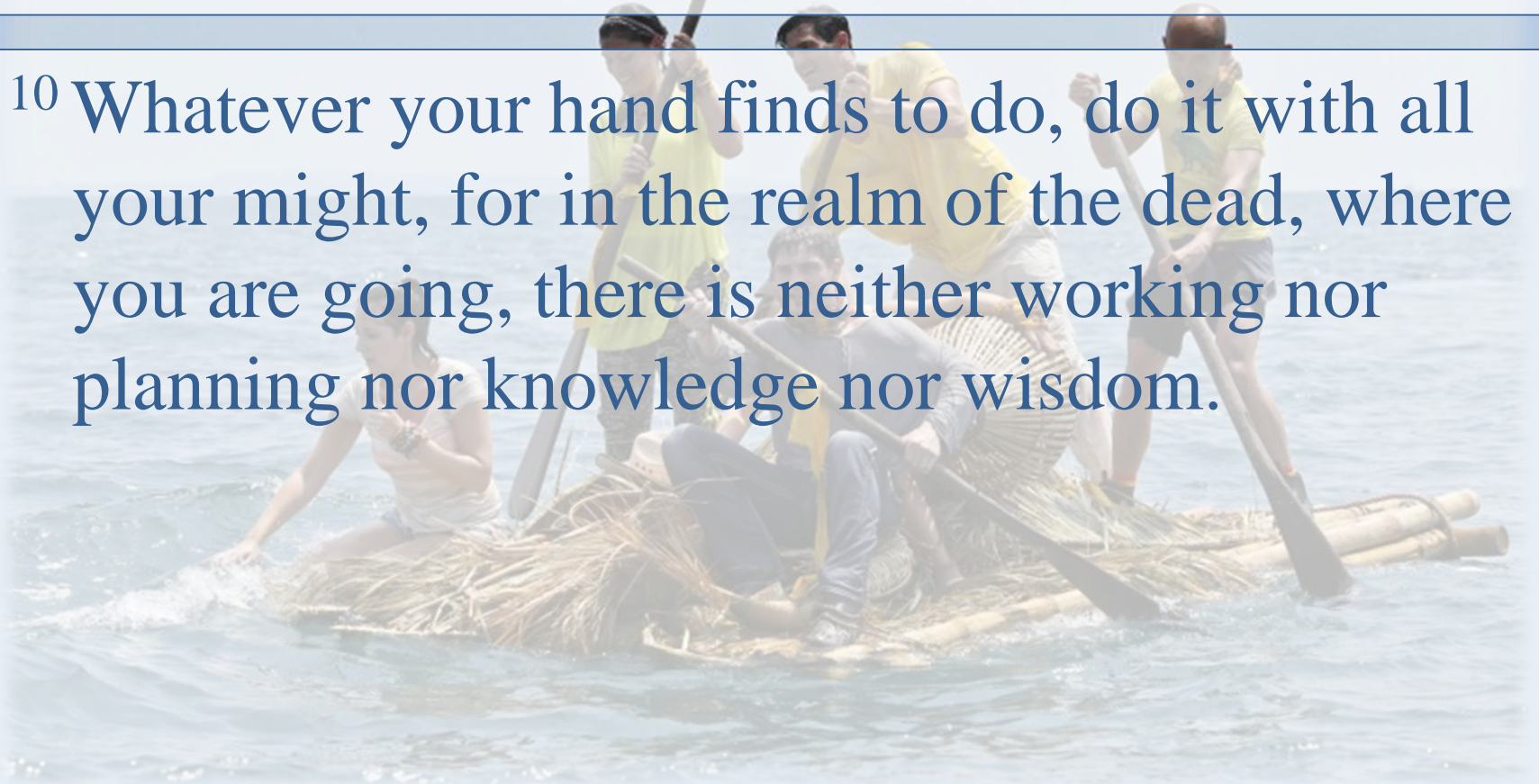
COLOSSIANS 3:23 (NIV)

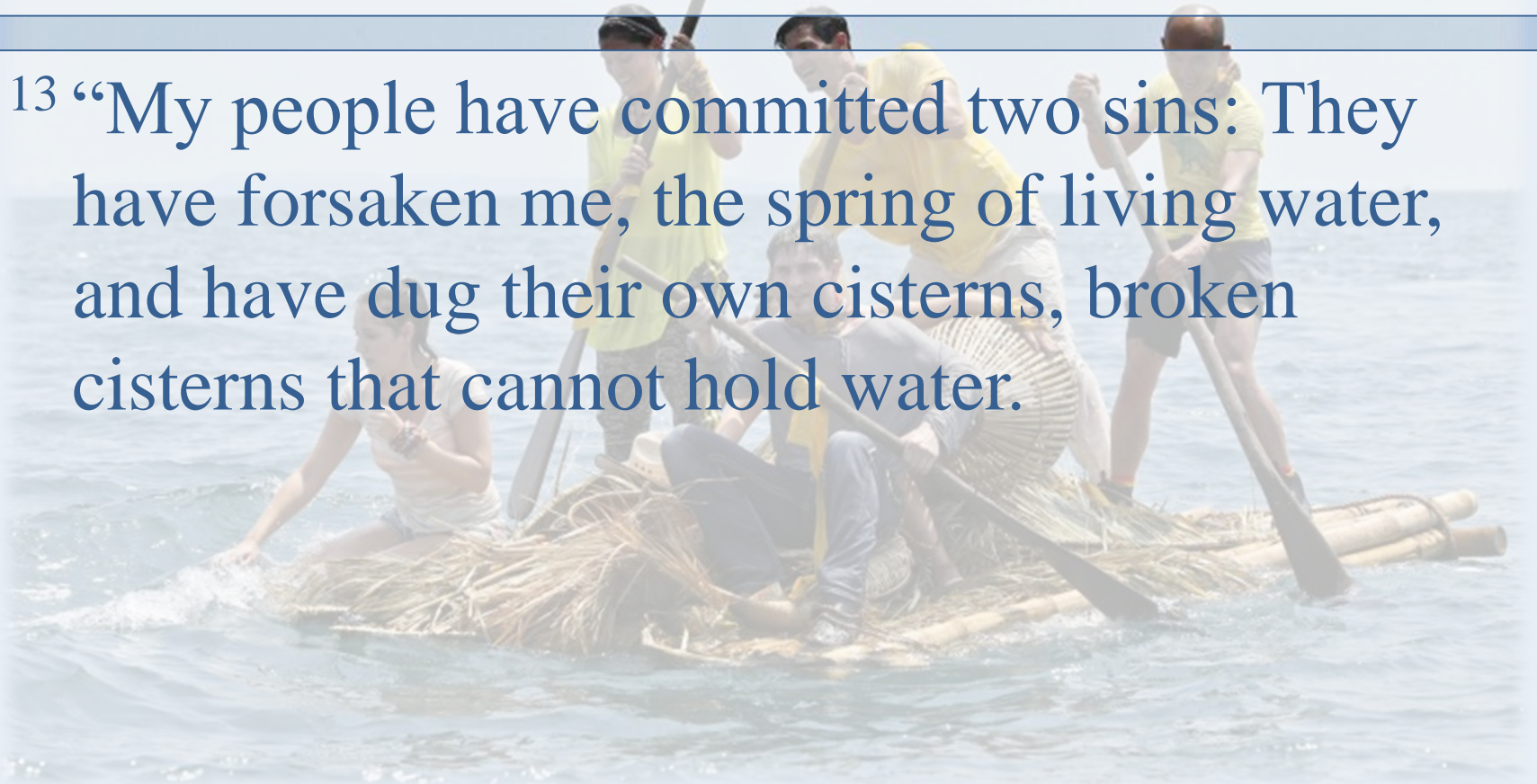

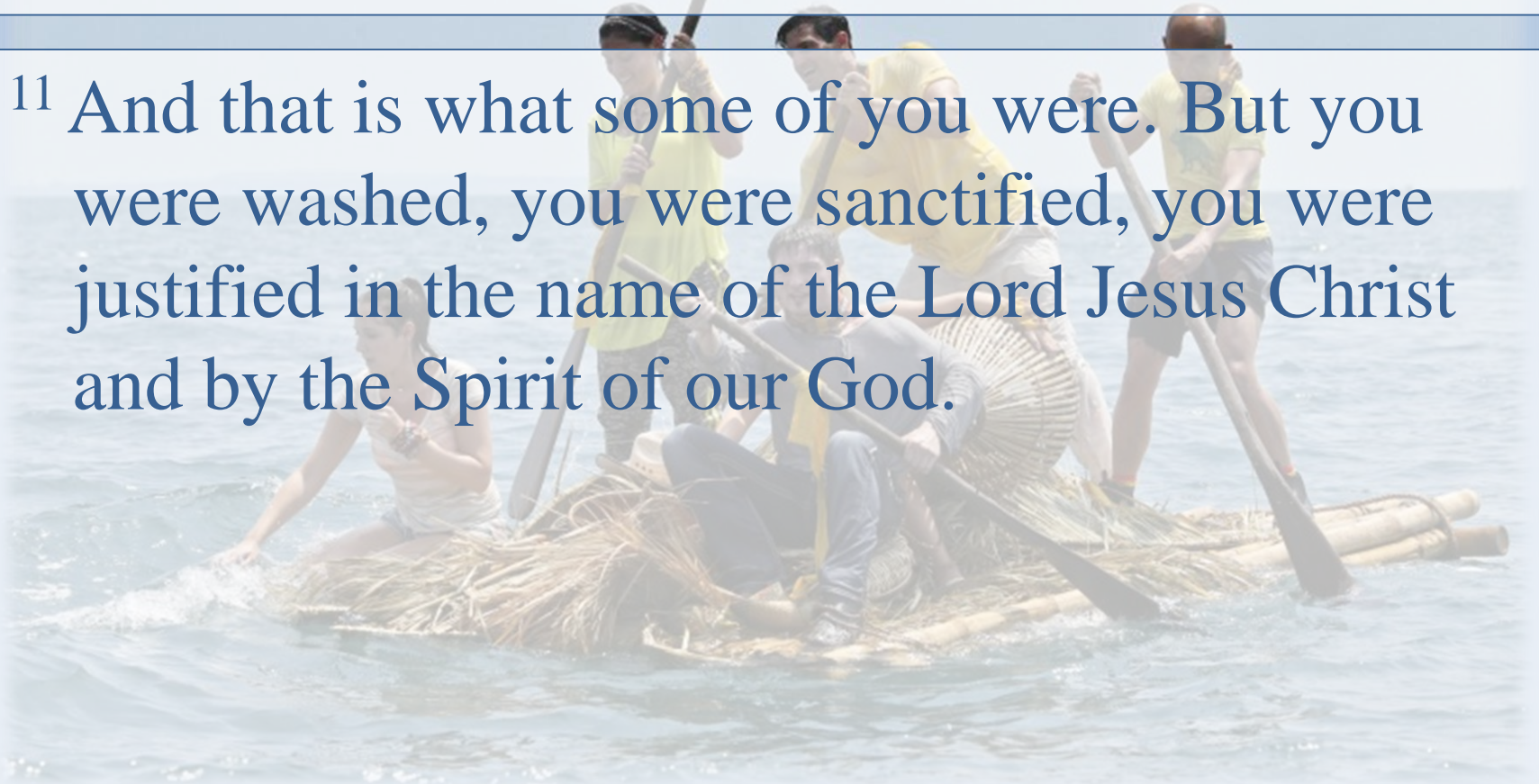

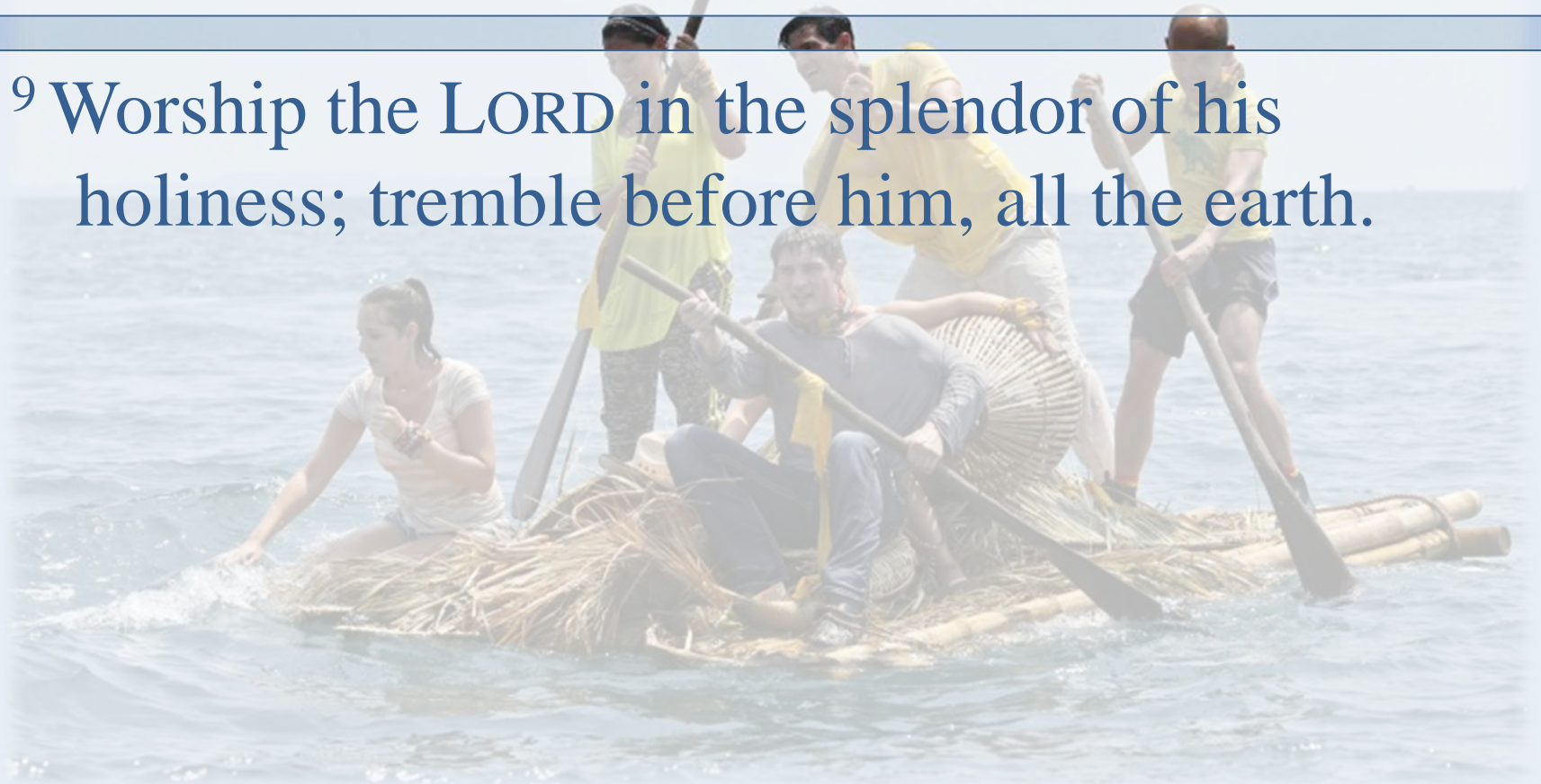
